

# INDIANA LOGISTICS RANKINGS

When compared to all other states, Indiana ranks in the top 10 in 100 significant logistics-related categories and in the top 5 for 27 of those.

## 1<sup>st</sup>

- Pass through interstates

In 2017, **504,599 RVs** were manufactured in the US which is a **17.2% increase** over the 430,691 units manufactured in 2016.

About **80% of all RVs** are manufactured in Elkhart County, which means that approximately **403,679 RVs were manufactured** in the Elkhart County area in 2017.
