




2018 ANNUAL REPORT

Business Facilities ranked Elkhart-Goshen Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) #2 in Job Growth for Mid-Sized MSAs and #7 in Economic Growth Potential for Small MSAs. Elkhart County was also ranked 5th on the list of US Counties with Fastest Job Growth by MarketWatch.

Our local companies also made national news with their successes. To name a few, Patrick Industries and Thor Industries made the Fortune Magazine's 2018 list of the 100 Fastest-Growing Companies. Thor Industries purchased German RV manufacturer Erwin Hymer Group SE to become the largest RV Maker in the world! Forest River created a new division called East to West and North to South RV. Lastly, Jason Lippert, CEO of LCI Industries, was named the 2018 EY Entrepreneur of the Year for the Midwest Region! What an exciting time to live and work in Elkhart County!

The Economic Development Corporation of Elkhart County (EDC) had a terrific year as well. They worked closely with Purdue MEP to host training classes for manufacturing companies. They helped Purdue MEP fill a need for 552 employees through Leadership Courses and classes like ISO Internal Auditing, Statistical Process Control, Cyber Security Awareness and many others. The EDC also continued to work closely with local companies to assist with their expansion needs. With the strong economy in 2018, many companies were looking to expand their operations, so the EDC reached out to offer their assistance in applying for state and local incentives. Grand Design RV was created in 2012 and operates as an independent business within Winnebago Industries. Based

in Middlebury, Grand Design manufactures towables and fifth-wheels. The EDC facilitated Elkhart County tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax incentives for a 12.5 M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility which could result in 266 new jobs upon successful completion of this project.



A division of Forest River, East to West is an RV startup that builds high quality RV's from concept to completion with a limited number of floor plans. The EDC facilitated City of

Elkhart tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax incentives for a \$15 M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility which resulted in 650 new jobs.



For over 40 years, L&W has been a leading Tier 1 supplier in the automotive industry, specializing in metal stamping,

welded assemblies, and hot stampings. The EDC facilitated State of Indiana tax incentives for a \$4.2M investment to costruct and equip a new manufacturing facility. 40 new jobs could be created from the successful completion of this project.



Lippert Components is a leading supplier of premium components to the recreational vehicle, manufactured housing, trailer, bus, marine and heavy truck

industries. The EDC facilitated City of Goshen tax phase-in incentives for a \$30M investment to design, construct and equip a new manufacturing facility. A total of 100 new jobs could be created from the successful completion of this project.



LOOK Trailers currently produces models ranging form the small entry-level 4'-wide enclosed cargo trailers to the 8.5'-wide custom built 53' goosenecks. The EDC

facilitated State of Indiana Tax incentives for a \$3M investment to contsruct and equip a new manufacturing facility in Bristol. A total of 100 jobs could be created from the completion of this project.



Pinnacle Seating, Inc., an Indiana based manufacturer of 24/7 Intensive use chairs, Ergonomic Office and Industrial chairs, R.V, Marine and speciality

Seating Applications. The EDC facilitated City of Elkhart tax phase-in incentives for a \$1.2M investment to construct a new manufacturing facilty. 15 new jobs could be created from the successful creation of this project.



Postle Aluminum has been producing extruded aluminum and specialized components for the recreational vehicle (RV) industry as well as other

industries since 1974. The EDC facilitated City of Elkhart tax phasein, rezoning, and annexation as well as State of Indiana incentives for an \$7.5M investment to modernize and equip an existing manufacturing facility that could create 20 new jobs.



For over 50 years, Satellite has been advance engineering their portable restrooms, restroom trailers, trucks,

and deodorizers to be stronger, last longer, and most importantly, be user friendly. The EDC facilitated Town of Bristol tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax Incentives for a \$9.6 M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility. 70 new jobs could be created from the successful completion of this project.



Tredit Tire and Wheel Company, Inc. is the leading assembler and distributor of tires, wheels and related accessories to trailer Original Equipment Manufacturers

(OEMs) throughout North America, including recreational vehicle (RV), cargo, utility, marine, horse/livestock, and heavy-duty equipment. The EDC facilitated City of Elkhart tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax incentives for a \$2.2M investment to equip an existing manufacturing facility. A total of 35 new jobs could be created from the successful completion of this project.



Truma develops, manufactures and sells heating and air conditioning systems, hot water boilers, maneuvering systems and products for energy and gas supply. The

EDC facilitated City of Elkhart tax phase-in incentives for a \$4.2M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility. 8 new jobs could be created from the completion of this project.



Tuscany is a Ford Authorized Specialty Vehicle Manufacturer. Tuscany has received Ford Motor Company's

Quality Excellence Award every year it was given, as well as recognition from Ford's Quality Vehicle Modifier program. The EDC facilitated City of Elkhart tax phase-in and State of Indiana incentives for a \$7.6M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility. 35 new jobs could be created upon the successful completion of this project.

US Rod Company,LLC is the parent company of US Rod Manufacturing, LLC, a premier sucker rod provider within their industry. The EDC facilitated City of Nappanee tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax incentives for a \$40.3 M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility. US Rod Manufacturing anticipates the creation of 75 new jobs upon successful completion of this project.



Wholesome Grain Solutions specializes in natural grain processing, refining, and product storage components using high

quality, non-GMO and organic Corn, Soybeans, and Soybean Meal as well as Non-GMO waxy corn. The EDC facilitated City of Nappanee tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax incentives for a \$2.7 M investment to construct and equip a new manufacturing facility. 9 new jobs could be created as a result of this project.



Winnebago Industries, Inc. is a leading U.S. manufacturer of outdoor lifestyle products under the Winnebago, Grand Design and Chris-Craft brands which builds quality

motorhomes, travel trailers, fifth wheel products and boats. The EDC facilitated Town of Middlebury tax phase-in and State of Indiana tax incentives for a \$12.3M investment to acquire land, construct, and equip a new manufacturing facility. 225 new jobs could be created from the completion of this project.

NOTABLE PROJECTS OF 2018

LaborShed Study

In 2018, the EDC of Elkhart County completed a LaborShed Study with the assistance of enFocus, a South Bend consulting company. The study included a Company Survey and a Worker Questionnaire. The Questionnaire received more than 600 responses that consisted of demographic, training, and commuting questions as well as employment status. We received answers from 87 companies in Elkhart County which included information on general hiring, hiring challenges, training and retention, and skill needs. enFocus also interviewed 10 of the 87 companies to gather more in-depth information on their responses. In 2019, we look forward to implementing the Action Plan that results from the surveys and continued discussions.

Ex-Offender Program


The EDC worked with the Indiana Department of Corrections and 8 correctional institutes to bring ex-offenders into the Elkhart County workforce in 2018. There were 11 companies in the county who were involved in the program and 291 ex-offenders that returned to Elkhart County. Many of these ex-offenders are trained and ready for a manufacturing position.

Elkhart County Veteran Support Program

The EDC worked closely with Work One's Veterans' Employment Representative, Mark Mathes, to create a program that would improve upon the quality of life for veterans currently living in Elkhart County. This is a three-tier program launched in October of 2018. It includes the creation of a Veteran Resource Booklet, a Veteran Support Group, and mentorship program. The resource booklet will be released at the beginning of 2019 with the mentorship program to follow closely behind. The Veteran Support Roundtable met twice in 2018 to discuss the booklet and strategies of how to move this initiative forward. The basis of this program is to make Elkhart County a true "veteran-friendly" community, not only to take care of our local veterans, but also to attract retiring military to our area.

Purdue MEP Training Courses

The EDC of Elkhart County's collaboration with Purdue University Manufacturing Extension Partnership (MEP) that began in 2017 is flourishing. What started out as a pilot program to address a need for accessible workforce training in the county has blossomed into a thriving partnership. In 2018, over 550 locally employed Hoosiers received training in courses such as Leadership Development, Risk Management, Kaizen Facilitation, and more. In addition, Purdue MEP delivered four informational sessions on Collaborative Robots ("Cobots")-industrial robots designed to work with and among employees. These are just an example of the training courses offered at the EDC through Purdue MEP.
